



Cairde Thuar Mhic Éadaigh 2019

What's it for?

To contribute towards the costs of running and maintaining sports facilities for the benefit of our GAA/LGFA/Handball club, schools, and community.

How can I help?

Give €5 per week, payable either in full in advance (€250 annual payment) or by standing order (€21 per month, €63 per quarter, or €250 per annum).

What do I receive?

All new and continuing patrons of this scheme are eligible to receive the following benefits in 2019:

1. Membership of CLG Thuar Mhic Éadaigh / Cumann Peil Gael na mBan / Handball Association
*In the case of families, it covers one parent/guardian as a full adult member, one parent/guardian as a social member plus **all** girls and boys players in same family up to age U-18 (or while attending college) as youth/adult members. Any individuals or families who have already paid GAA/LGFA/Handball membership fees can opt for a "top up" to the Cairde Thuar Mhic Éadaigh package by paying the difference.*
2. Entry into Mayo GAA Club Development Draw 2019 (value €100).
Six monthly draws (May to October 2019) with a total of 222 cash prizes up for grabs as follows: 2 @ €10,000; 4 @ €5,000; 6 @ €1,000; 30 @ €500; 180 @ €200. (Our club had 42 winners in the past 5 years).
3. One entry into weekly CLG Thuar Mhic Éadaigh "Lotto" draw until April 30, 2020. The jackpot currently stands at €12,200 (February 2019).
If the weekly jackpot is not won, consolation prizes are paid out and jackpot increases by €100 for the next draw.
4. New members 2019: Special embroidered club jacket exclusive to patrons of Cairde Thuar Mhic Éadaigh
Existing members previously received jackets in 2014, 2016 and 2018.
5. Free admission into all home games (excluding county championships).
6. Special discount rate on Ionad Spóirt gymnasium membership: for top-up annual payment of €50, all family members over age of 16 can use our club gymnasium.
